Welcome To Sharjah Museums



- → All educational programmes start at 10:00 am and end at 12:00 pm
- → Kindly, specify the type of disability and cognitive age in the booking form to provide the suitable activities and materials
- → All workshops are limited to 15 attendees (including caregivers) except for workshops that are designed for people with visual disability and autism; they are limited to 6 attendees to ensure high quality
- → Kids should not be left without caregivers in galleries or workshops' areas
